

Earlston High School Amey - Traffic Management Plan

An assessment of the traffic management of the school was carried out in January 2016 in order to ensure the safety of all pupils, staff, parents and visitors. It is important that all users of our campus adhere to this plan to ensure the safety of all.

Start of the school day:

0830-0900 hours - No vehicles to be allowed beyond the gates. This will be managed by Amey staff.

Exceptions

- Deliveries for Kitchen
- Buses
- Anyone dropping off anyone with mobility issues / taxis
- Blue Badge Holders
- Emergency Vehicles

End of the school day:

1530-1600 hours - No vehicles to be allowed beyond the gates. This will be managed by Amey staff.

A member of senior staff will be present when pupils are boarding the buses.

Exceptions

- Buses
- Anyone picking up those with mobility issues / taxis
- Blue badge holders
- Emergency vehicles

Please note:

Staff Car Park

This car park is designated for all campus staff. For use by school staff only. In the event of flooding, Amey will direct staff to alternative parking.

Layby

Staff should leave this area clear and park within the staff car park. All other users can park in the designated layby.



Visitors parking

Please note that this area is for visitors only. Disabled Parking is provided for blue badge holders and anyone who requires access for mobility reasons.

Georgefield Road Gate

This area should **not** be used for parking as it is to allow for emergency vehicles and access for deliveries / loading.

In the event of flooding, Amey will direct staff to alternative parking.
