## What is Humanities at EHS?

Humanities comprises of 4 subject areas of Geography, History, Modern Studies and Religious & Moral Education.

# What do students study?

Our comprehensive Programmes of Study will show you our learning journey through both content and skills across Humanities. This is also an opportunity for parents/carers to support knowing what topics students are studying when.

#### Content?

All lesson materials where appropriate will be shared with students using Teams. This is to allow access when both in and out of the classroom. Students are encouraged to take charged iPads to every lesson.

#### Skills?

We have a clear skills progression focus across Humanities which we feel gives students the best chance of success at the senior phase. These are clear to students within each classroom and course and are highlighted in the Programmes of Study.

### Homework?

Students receive regular homework in Humanities. All tasks will be set using Sachel One. Students have the option of handing these tasks in via Teams Assignments or in class using their jotters. We have a clear 100% Homework Policy across every classroom.

# **Progress?**

Students will be made aware of their progress from feedback on classwork, homeworks & assessments.

In S1-3 BGE we use a Red/Amber/Green system based on success criteria of the task set. Red (under 50%) Amber (50%-74%) Green (over 75%). Students are supported to record their progress as they move through their programmes of study.

We encourage parents/carers to discuss progression and learning with students.
