

Pupil Visit - Wednesday 7th and Thursday 8th June

This visit is an important part of the transfer arrangements and is an ideal opportunity for pupils to experience a full two days here at Earlston High School.

On arrival at Earlston HS the pupils will register at the Assembly Hall and then be split into classes, to follow a first year timetable, which will differ from the timetable they will receive and follow in August. Further arrangements for their visit will then be explained. They will be supported by 6th year pupils when moving around the school, who will explain as much about the school as they can on their way round. One period will be allocated to allow pupils to meet with their Guidance Teacher. Senior pupils and staff will be more than happy to answer any questions throughout the two days.

Lunch will be provided free of charge for both days in the school canteen and pupils will have free choice from the menu. If any pupil does not wish to take advantage of this, they should bring a packed lunch with them.

Pupils are required to bring a pencil case and P.E. kit on both days.

Pupils should wear the full primary school uniform during the two day visit. Although P7 pupils will be excited about receiving their leavers hoodies, hoodies should not be worn during the visit due to the health and safety rules that must be followed in our practical subjects.

Pupils will be informed of travel arrangements by their Primary School. Scottish Borders Council Passenger Transport arrange bus passes through the primary schools for any pupil who is entitled to transport. However, pupils for whom School Placement Request Forms have been accepted must make their own transport arrangements.
