- Re-format GOOD
 - Make a one-page list of key content
 - Or a timeline
 - Turn into a podcast
 - Or flashcards
- Visualise GOOD
 - Annotate
 - add pictures
 - mind-map,re-shape
- Practice ESSENTIAL
 - Past paper questions
- Quiz EXCELLENT
 - Content knowledge
